WELCOME TO EASTERTIDE



Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

We have just finished "The Gospel According to Hollywood" a six week long Lenten class that included exquisite food (NVC does potlucks really well!), a wonderful, six great movies about Jesus (that were all very different) and discussions about them all. If we ever do this Lenten class again I highly recommend attending! As our class was wrapping up we had a meaningful Palm/Passion Sunday in the Sanctuary with wonderful music and a sermon on both the Palm Parade welcome and the week of Passion Jesus experienced. Later in the afternoon we hosted a very successful Ice Cream Social and egg hunt for Nahant children and families- with a special visit by the Easter Bunny, crafts, a story and singing.


On Holy Thursday we hosted a powerful Maundy Thursday service in Swansburg Hall that we shared with our brothers and sisters from the Unitarian Universalist Church of the Greater Lynn Area. Rev. Victoria Weinstein co-officiated the service as we read the Passion Story from the Gospel of Mark, prayed, sang, heard good music and shared communion.

On Easter a number of us welcomed the sunrise with word, song and communion as the bagpipe music of Chris Whitlock welcomed us and the sun. Afterwards there was a great breakfast at the church. At 10:30 we gathered for our traditional Easter Service, with a sermon, readings and exceptional music by Rich, Ute, the Nahant Women's Choir, Tanya Blaich,

the bells, Cal, and Bill – and the gathered also sang Easter hymns as well.

In short, March was packed with a lot of things going on which culminated in our wonderful Easter service. But Easter is not over in March. On the church liturgical calendar we are in Eastertide all of April. It's traditionally a time of celebrating the resurrection of Christ. The color of the paraments are white reflecting the celebration. The Lectionary lessons lift up the resurrection, the acts of the apostles and early church formation and lessons. Eastertide lasts for fifty days until Pentecost (May 19th, the same day as our annual meeting). We hope that you will join us in the continuing celebration of the resurrection and Good News on Sundays at 10:30 in the Chapel.


