## JUST THE FACTS ABOUT PEACE VILLAGE

When & where is Peace Village?
Peace Village will be held Aug. 14-16from 9:30
a.m. - 3 p.m. at Flash Road Playground. On the last afternoon, families are invited to the closing celebration!

How Much does it cost?

Peace Village is generously funded through resources provided by NVC. Families are asked to contribute a \$25 donation per child to help cover costs. If you are able to give more, we will gratefully receive it. If the cost is a hardship, scholarships are available.

Who are Peace Village participants? The program is available to 30 kids who must be rising 1-6 graders. We expect to have a Buddhist, Jewish, & Christian teachers. Children of all religious/spiritual traditions are encouraged to apply. Registrations are accepted on a first come, first serve basis starting June 1st..

Who are the leaders?
Representatives from NVC, college peace
workers, as well as interfaith representatives will
supervise children attend activities and lead
peace related classes, circle gatherings, song and
