She moved on to the state's Attorney General's office before moving to Washington to work for the U.S. Department of Commerce and gained experience in Eastern Europe and China. She then worked for a big D.C. law firm before completing her career as the legislative counsel for the United Steelworkers.


The sandwiches will need to be bagged along with a napkin, juice box and snack.

No registration needed - just show up and we'll put you to work!








Rex Antrim & Robert Wilson packed them in with their talk on the history of the Townie Class race boat during August's Community Breakfast.

### **ZOOM WORSHIP SERVICES**




